<b>1</b> Mary Magdalene	Jerusalem, tomb	Resurrection Sunday	Mark 16:9-11, John 20:11-18
<i>Jesus said to her, "Do not cling to me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father; but go to my brothers and say to them, 'I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.'"</i>			
<b>2</b> Other women	Jerusalem	Resurrection Sunday	Matt 28:9-10
<i>"Greetings!" And they came up and took hold of his feet and worshiped him. Then Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid; go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee, and there they will see me."</i>			
<b>3</b> 2 disciples	Road to Emmaus	Resurrection Sunday	Mark 16:12-13, Luke 24:13-32
<i>"O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken! Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?" And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself.</i>			
<b>4</b> Peter	Jerusalem	Resurrection Sunday	Luke 24:34, 1 Cor 15:5
<i>"The Lord has risen indeed, and has appeared to Simon!"</i>			
<b>5</b> 10 disciples (Thomas absent)	Jerusalem, upper room	Resurrection Sunday	Luke 24:36-43, John 20:19-25
<i>"Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you." And with that he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive anyone's sins, their sins are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven."</i>			
<b>6</b> 11 disciples	Jerusalem, upper room	Following Sunday	Mark 16:14, John 20:26-31, 1Cor15:5
<i>Though the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe."</i>			
<b>7</b> 7 disciples fishing	Sea of Galilee	Unknown	John 21:1-14
<i>He said, "Throw your net on the right side of the boat and you will find some." When they did, they were unable to haul the net in because of the large number of fish.</i>			
<b>8</b> 11 disciples	Mountain in Galilee	Unknown	Matt 28:16-20, Mark 16:15-18
<i>"All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."</i>			
<b>9</b> Crowd of over 500	Unknown	Unknown	1 Cor 15:6
<i>Then he appeared to more than five hundred brothers at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have fallen asleep.</i>			
<b>10</b> James (Jesus' brother)	Unknown	Unknown	1 Cor 15:7
<b>11</b> Disciples during ascension	Mount of Olives	40 days after resurrection	Luke24:36-51, Acts1:3-9, 1Cor15:7
<i>He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons that the Father has fixed by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."</i>			
<b>12</b> Paul	Damascus	Seval years later	Acts 9,22,26 & 1 Cor 9:1
<i>And falling to the ground, he heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?" And he said, "Who are you, Lord?" And he said, "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting. But rise and enter the city, and you will be told what you are to do."</i>
